



Route Forch Pfannenstil Lützelsee

Forch

This leisurely cycle route is about 29 km long and takes you along the top of the Pfannenstil crest to Rapperswil.

Through a variegated landscape of woodland and meadows. Starting in Forch (which is best reached by the "S18" train from Zurich-Stadelhofen), there is a steady climb to Hochwacht with a predominant observation tower. The magnificent all-round view is, however, ample reward for all the legwork. The route then continues to undulate gently through a patchwork of woodland and pastures. Grüningen is well worth a stop on account of its magnificent castle and the town's intact medieval skyline. A small lake called Lützelsee is the final feature on the route, before you approach Rapperswil. For your return to Zurich, you have the choice between taking the train or one of the boats operated by the ZSG.
